### Louisiana boys head to USSR in basketball exchange plan

Ultimate has reached high school basketball:

The St. Amant (La.) boys go to the Soviet Union Tuesday for three games in Moscow and one in Leningrad.

St. Amant coach Kent Schexnaydre said, "It's more than just some basketball games."

#### HIGH SCHOOL NOTES

The exchange was arranged by David Young, a Lufthansa businessman and boyhood friend of Schexnaydre, and Alexander Gorodetsky, president of the Soviet Basketball Federation and former coach of the Soviet national team.

St. Amant is taking 15 players, two coaches, the principal and a referee. On the agenda: a reception at the Kremlin, tours of the Kremlin, Red Square and Gorky Park and a visit to the Moscow Circus.

St. Amant plays Moscow High No. 1, some Moscow schools' the Soviet Olympic reserve team and the Leningrad Sports Academy.

St. Amant, about 30 miles south of Baton Rouge, has 1,500 students. The Golden Gaels (14) started 1-6.

"We're not sure what to expect — it's a little tough getting scouting reports," Schexnaydre said.

#### Coach's boys

Coach Bob Hurley of Je-

sey City (N.J.) St. Anthony, No. 5 in the USA TODAY Super 25 poll, says he misses his son, Bobby, a freshman starting guard at Duke University.

But he still has son Danny, a junior starting guard.

Danny, 6-0 and 150 pounds — 4 inches taller and 18 pounds heavier than last season — averages 14 points for the Friars (3-0).


"He may be ahead of Bobby in some areas — he plays good defense and he's a better outside shooter. He's got a bigger frame and will carry more weight. He's a lefthander's righty."

Danny sat out last season after breaking the index finger on his left hand.

Hurley, a Jersey City probation officer, said he might retire after Danny graduates, which would give him 10 seasons at St. Anthony. But he might stay for Rodriek Rhodes' senior year.

Rhodes, a 6-7 sophomore, started as a freshman and is averaging 15 points.

"Somebody asked Danny where he'd like to go to college and he said he might like to go South, but you know how kids are," Hurley said. "He doesn't know what he will do tomorrow."

# Gonzales Man To Play Role In Summit

A Gonzales, La. man will play a role at the summit this week between President Reagan and Soviet Secretary General Gorbachev.

According to the Soviet Agency Intersevera, David Young, of Chincoteague, has been invited by the Soviet government to coordinate the visit of Chef John D. Folse, who will operate a Louisiana restaurant at the Moscow World Trade Center May 25-June 3.

Young is also working with the Soviets to arrange meetings for Baton Rouge Mayor Pat Schexnayder and Louisiana Commissioner of Agriculture Bob Odum, the Soviet government reported.

"We are pleased for you to coordinate the visit of Chef Folse said Pavel I. Ichikai, Director of National Cuisine.

Young said the visit of Chef Folse has captured the imagination of the world media, including most of the major American television networks.

Young, President of Media Magic in Gonzales, said he also received a call from the White House this week offering support and assistance.

Folse said this week that he expected President Reagan and General Gorbachev to drop by his restaurant at least once.

Young said the Soviets have agreed to allow Folse to operate his "Louisiana Landing East" in the Hotel Mezhdunarodnyaya, which will also house the international press and the White House staff in Moscow.

"This could be a truly wonderful opportunity for Louisiana," Young said. Experts predict the Soviet government may loosen import laws when the INF treaty is approved and perhaps may be in a position to purchase badly needed foodstuffs for the Soviet people. That is what Odum wants to discuss with the Soviets, he added.

In any case, said Young, the Louisiana Chef in Moscow will focus international attention on the states food and culture at a time when it could truly use some good news.

He said 25,000 pounds of Louisiana seafood and American foodstuffs were shipped to the Soviet Union last week to supply Folse's Restaurant.

He said the trip has been endorsed by Gov. Buddy Roemer and Lt. Gov. Paul Harry, head of the state's tourism industry.

"This is a once in a lifetime opportunity," Young said before he left for Moscow on Friday. "I feel very, very fortunate to have even a very small role in this historic occasion."





Ladies and gentlemen: Mr. P. Bassett Esq.

I would wish to contribute the resolution to speak  
for Thomas Jefferson in the session of his  
still surviving deliberation.

Today, as yesterday, the man born ~~here~~ <sup>here</sup> and  
a half century ago is still a magnet capable  
of attracting the hearts and minds of the  
one generation.

We did not then complete ~~the~~ an ancient monarchy  
or a government to himself. He is now in the  
flow of time, slowing our heart and making the life  
and aspects of his personality heavy and a day  
and complicated. Mr. Jefferson remains unworn by your  
~~old~~ hours of toil and the down moments of life.  
He is in the 83rd of existence the Delphic Oracle of  
Independence has lost its authority and the most  
curious thing of all - it is getting older every day

We highly value the cooperation we received from private citizens and believe that type of relationship helps to strengthen our country.




